What it is not:

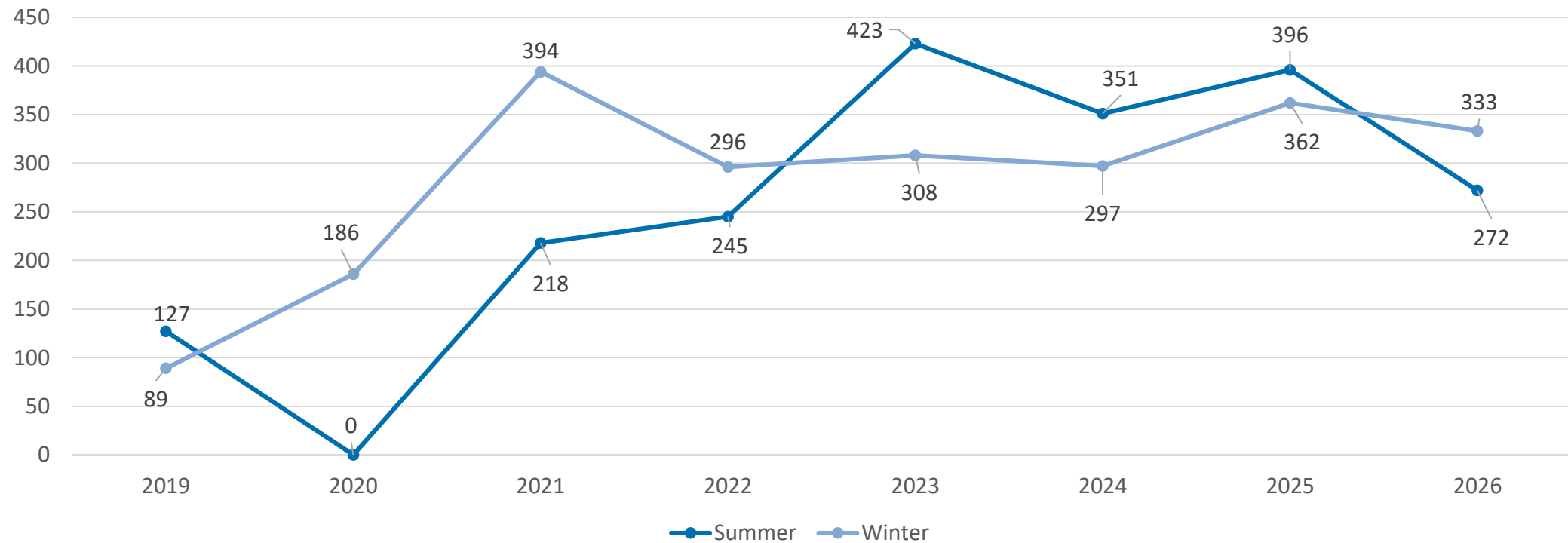
- Project Inventory

- To gain a better understanding of the number of individuals experiencing unsheltered homelessness in our CoC.

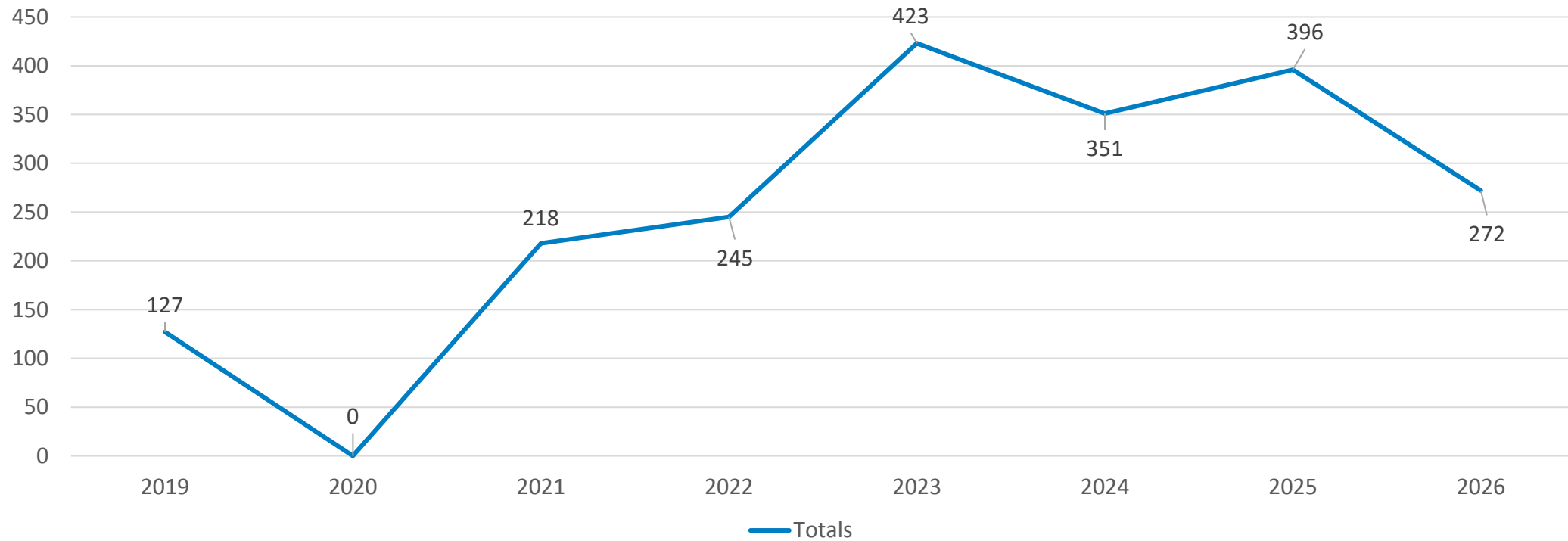
Unsheltered Totals Over Time

Summer and Winter Unsheltered Totals 2019 - 2026



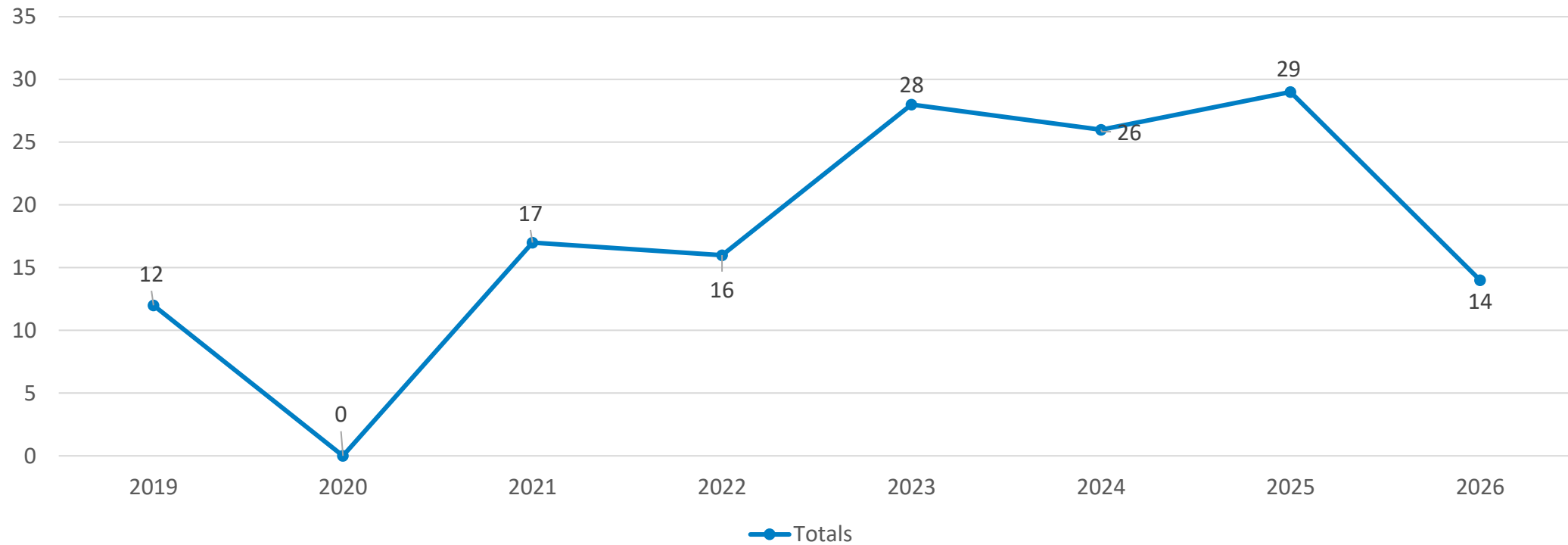
Unsheltered PIT Totals

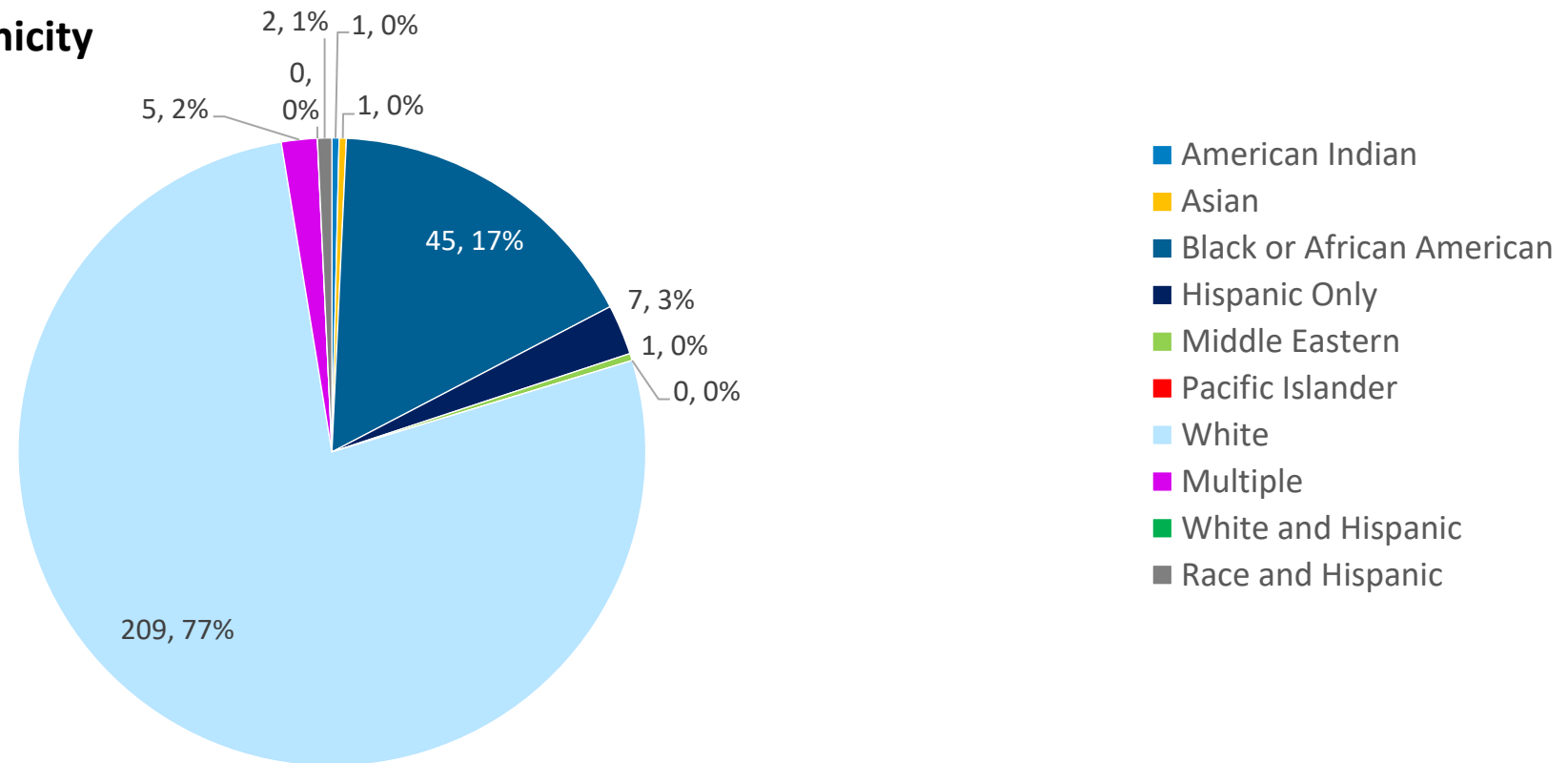

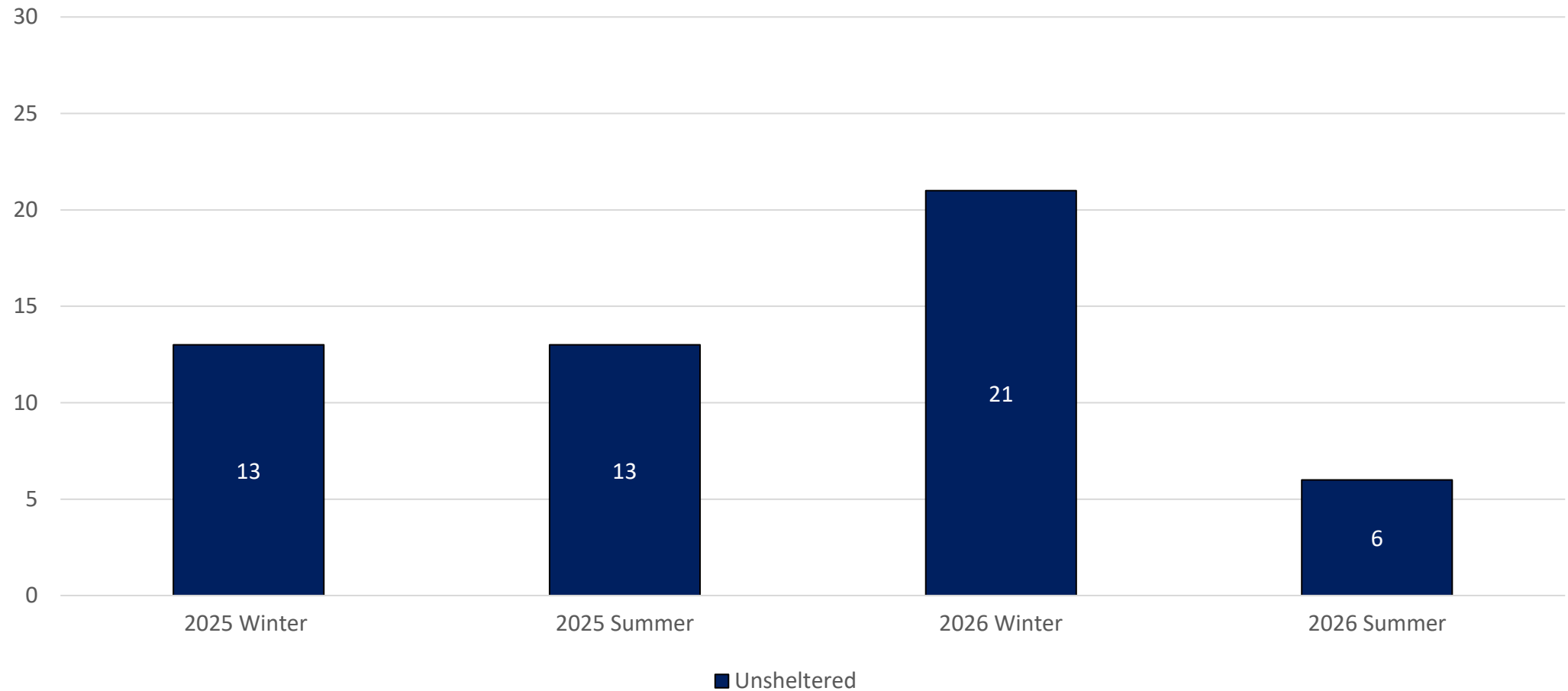

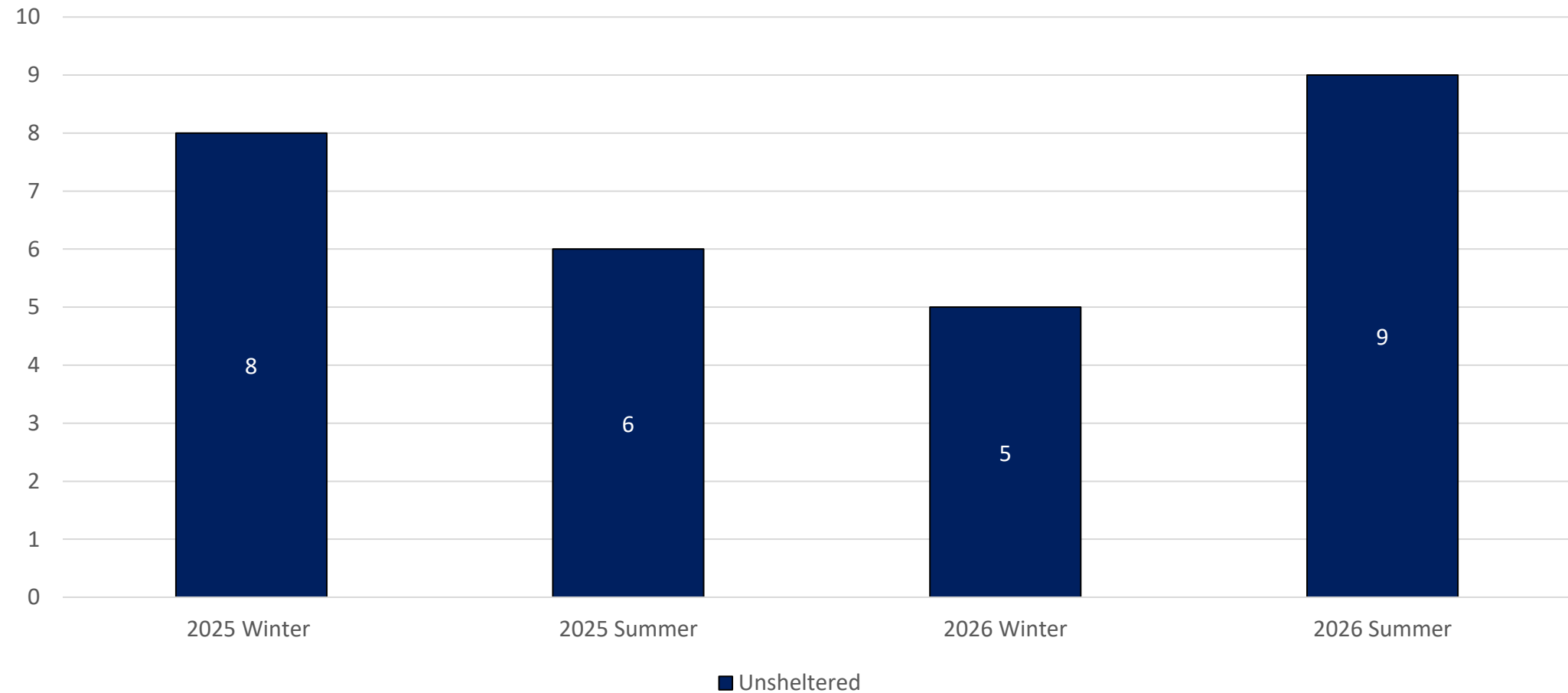

Youth Totals



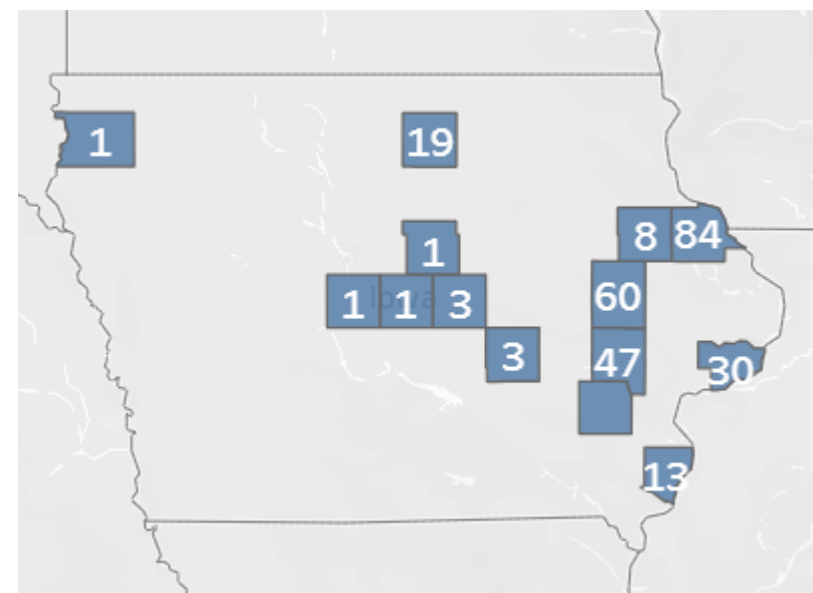
Veteran Totals
